Jerome Bruder is an attorney practicing in Monroe Township for the past 21 years. The firm of Bolster & Bruder has its roots in Monroe Township, having started as the firm of Dickerson & Devoe in 1969. The firm was part time since Monroe Township did not have a large population. In 1979, George F. Bolster commenced practicing full time and the firm became Dickerson, Devoe & Bolster. In 1988 Jerome J. Bruder and George F. Bolster formed Bolster & Bruder.

Mr. Bruder's practice in the area of Elder Law and Medicaid planning has increased dramatically in the past 15 years. He attributes this to clients living longer and needing to plan for the preservation of their assets, rather than having them expended for nursing home and assisted living costs.

In September 2009 Bolster & Bruder established a banking relationship with The Bank of Princeton for many of its client estate and trust accounts. The Bank of Princeton has provided a messenger service which picks up bank transactions twice each week.
